In line with Scandinavian educational tradition, children are given a choice to wear what they choose. The school does endeavours to maintain a smart functional dress code. All items must be clearly labelled with a sewn-in nametape. All children will need seasonal clothing such as waterproof clothing and waterproof boots. Dress up or sportswear is not acceptable during the normal school day. Indoor shoes are required.

On outings and trips children are expected to wear official Dania T-shirts and Dania sweatshirts.

Footwear:

Pupils must be able to put on and take off their own shoes. If necessary, this may mean pupils wearing shoes that fasten with Velcro or buckles. No laces in Reception/Year1 please.
